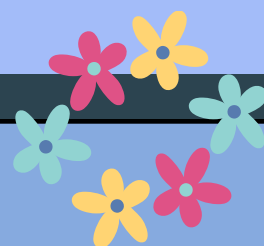

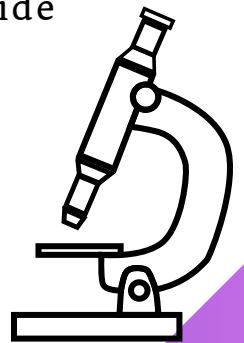
SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

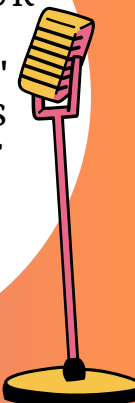

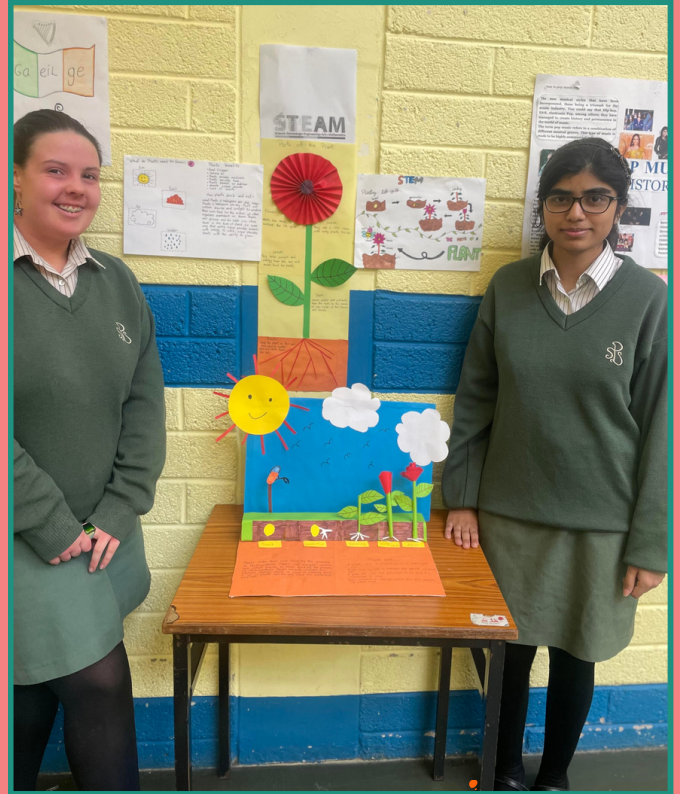
